### Activity description

#### How does it work?

- An online link will be provided to the volunteers who want to participate in the activity
- Guidelines and tips are provided in the link

- Write an encouraging thank you note to a community frontline worker to recognize them for their commitment and effort throughout the pandemic. A note with positive messages and thanks is uplifting. You can write the note by yourself or with family and friends
- UW will collect these thought-filled notes and send them to community frontline workers in United Way's network of agencies

#### **Timing**

The activity can take anywhere from 15 to 60 minutes to complete.

- Any volunteer can participate
- Volunteers that can write notes in different languages are welcome
