Employment & Economic Stability: Eligible Project Objectives

- Strengthening local workforce development models
- Evaluation efforts related to employment, economic development



Housing Stability: Eligible Project Objectives

- Encourage community voices in housing discussions and policies
- Increasing education on tenant rights, and support for tenant led groups, eviction prevention

- Mobilize resources and collaborative activities to effectively action local priorities.

CAG Amounts and Cycle

Initiatives led by local residents or small groups active in the South Markham community.

The requested amount may be between \$5,000 - \$20,000 per project.

Expected to be delivered over a period of 6 months or less and completed by August 31, 2026.



Project Eligibility Criteria

Operate in South Markham Focus on South Markham and project timeframe of 6 months or less Project have at least 5 residents submitting, with two identified as primary leads Deliver on at least 1 of the Grant Focus Areas



Resident Eligibility Criteria



Live in the South Markham neighbourhood

Should <u>not</u> be leading this grant as part of their employment



A resident can only be listed as the 'primary lead' once



Must be willing to work with ACSA Community Services as the project trustee

CAG applications available as of Monday, June 9th 2025

Agency/Collaborative CAG


Projects or initiatives will be led by a local agency, collaborative or group of partners in South Markham

The requested amount may range from \$25,000 to \$75,000 per project

Projects expected to be delivered over a period of up to 18 months (must be completed by May 31st, 2027).



Agency/Collaborative Project Eligibility Criteria



Occur within 18 months, and must end by May 2027

Project may be part of a broader initiative but must include activities in South Markham. Project must seek to deliver on one (1) of the Grant Focus Areas.



Lead Agency Eligibility Criteria

WORKING WITH COMMUNITIES IN

& YORK REGION

Is a registered charitable organization, or an incorporated non-profit organization* for a minimum of 2 years

Have financial statements for at least 1 year (audited) or be trusteed by a registered charity that has financial statements for at least one year

Must operate in South Markham and complete a collaborative agreement if applying as a collaborative



If revenue is less than \$100,000, have a review engagement for at least one fiscal year, conducted by a licensed public accountant



Only 1 application per project lead agency is eligible to be approved
