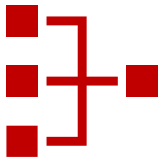

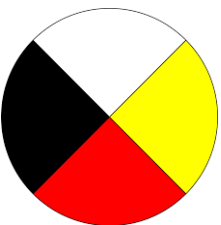

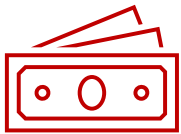
Community Real Estate

The UWGT Community Real Estate Initiative aims to sustain not-for-profit (NFP) organizations in the pursuit of their missions by enabling control over their locations through ownership and public partnerships, providing sustainable community space.

UWGT interventions will:

- Protect not-for-profit organizations from market pressure, making them more resilient to displacement and enabling them to protect housing and community services to address poverty in inclusive communities.
- Empower not-for-profit organizations to maintain their presence in high demand areas.

Goals of UWGT Community Real Estate Initiative



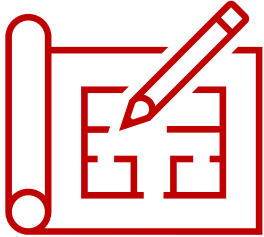
Provide Funding - Ensuring grant and financing opportunities are made available for non-profit service organizations that focus on meeting community needs and emerging opportunities.



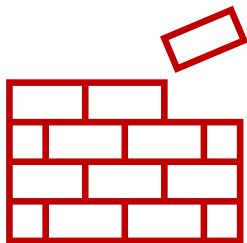
Provide Space(s) - Supporting an increase in non-profit public assets focused on community partners and the UWGT Hub Strategy.



Provide Capacity Building- Facilitating opportunities for non-profit service organizations participate in knowledge building relevant to needs, as well as direct support opportunities and mentorship opportunities.



- 1. Enable pre-development** which includes costs related to the pre-construction phase of a project including consulting studies, municipal approvals, and site assessments.



- 2. Small capital project implementation** which includes costs related to the construction and fit out of community service space(s), including mechanical, electrical and plumbing.

Funding Term:

Up to 2 years (April 1, 2026 – March 31, 2028)

Funding Range:

- \$50,000 - \$250,000 per project
- Applicants may apply for more than one project, however it is unlikely that more than one project will be funded per agency, given the limited amount of funding

Eligibility Criteria - general

- ✓ Alignment with UWGT priorities
- ✓ Ownership/ Lease Status
- ✓ Impact and evaluation
- ✓ Use of funds
- ✓ Agency capacity to deliver the project



ECSSC Grant Funding Priorities

- ❖ Projects that help **expand service provision** and increase access or capacity of services currently provided
- ❖ Projects that promote **collaboration & enhanced service coordination**
- ❖ Projects that demonstrate **environmental and financial sustainability.**
- ❖ Projects that are **funding ready and operationally feasible.**
- ❖ **Population:** Projects for and with Indigenous, Black and or structurally disadvantaged populations, and are culturally responsive
- ❖ **Geography:** Projects that address unmet needs in high-growth, high density or underserved areas.

ECSSC - Funding Criteria

UWGT will not fund:



Projects that are located in a property that is leased in the private market; (i.e., the project is located in a retail storefront owned by a for-profit landlord)



Projects that are located in a property with legal claims against it. (Please note, property and title searches will be conducted to ensure eligibility)



Agencies that received the ECSSC Grant in 2024-2025 and have not yet completed all funded phases/reporting.

Documents required for upload include:

- 1) Letters patent / articles of incorporation**
- 2) Property/zoning report (if applicable)**
- 3) Project Plan**
- 4) Project Budget**
- 5) Photos of location**

- **Start early! Waiting to ask for support just before the deadline is risky.**
- **Submit on-time - late applications will not be considered.**
- **Lots of check-boxes to reduce admin burden.**
- **Respond to the questions for any reader - including those who are not familiar with your work or organization.**
- **Be concise: quality of content > quantity of words.**
- **Word maximums are limits not guides - we hope you will write less than the limit.**
