Frequently Asked Questions



- **Can I provide for my family and leave a gift in my will?**

Absolutely. Many of our supporters choose to take care of their loved ones first and then leave a percentage or specific amount to United Way. Your lawyer or financial advisor can help you structure a gift that reflects your priorities and circumstances, and that considers your financial goals and tax situation.

- **Isn't this kind of gift only for the wealthy?**

Not at all! Most legacy gifts come from everyday people who want their values to live on. You don't need a large estate to make a difference. Gifts of any size create a lasting impact.

- **Do I have to redo my entire will?**

In many cases, no. If your will is already up to date, you can often add a codicil to include a charitable gift and it's usually a straightforward update. Your lawyer can advise on the best approach.

- **Should I speak with my family?**

It's a good idea. Talking with your family helps ensure your wishes are understood and respected. Clear communication brings peace of mind for everyone. These conversations can also spark meaningful dialogue about the values you share.
